台北

- **西门町** - 西门町现在被称为台北的「原宿」,除了有日文杂志专卖店外,各种日本的书籍、唱片、服饰等,几乎都同步流行,是所谓「哈日族」的天堂。
- **士林夜市** - 是台北市大规模的观光夜市,因邻近学区拥有众多年轻族群客层,加上捷运站及公车交通便利而成为具有指标性的夜市。士林夜市拥有众多小吃美食,像是士林大香肠,蚵仔煎,臭豆腐,冰品及大饼包小饼等。
- **十分老街** - 特色不在于老建筑,火车门前过是十分老街全台独特的街景.狭窄的街道,火车就从两排民宅的中间驶过.街道两侧有许多店家贩售天灯,在铁道上放天灯,形成老街,铁道,天灯相映成趣的画面。
- **九份老街** - 独特的旧式建筑,坡地以及风情,使九份成为台湾最受欢迎的观光景点之一。这里还可以品尝到草仔粿、蕃薯丸、芋头丸、潮州鱼丸等各式小吃。

南投

- **清境青青草原** - 清境农场人气最旺的景点,其中以[羊咩咩脱衣秀]最富有盛名.绵延不尽的青青草原,牛羊群不是穿梭,恍如北国风光,享有[雾上桃园]之称。
- **小瑞士花园** - 因具有北欧光之美素有「台湾小瑞士」,「雾上桃园」之美名,故而取名为「清境小瑞士花园」。破晓的清境云雾,像幅画中飘逸的泼墨山水,极目远眺,山岚正以渐进的方式弥漫开来,与远山云影合而回一,此时的山林田野纯净之美,令人心旷神怡。
- **纸箱王** - 位于南投县仁爱乡,海拔约1800公尺高的纸箱王,天气的变换可以在不同的时间变换不同的美景,万里无云的早上烈日高照,拍起照片每个人都是阳光少男少女;下午云雾飘渺颇具诗意,漫步在清境的旅人显得悠哉。
- **日月潭风景区** - 闻名中外日月潭为台湾八景之一,日月潭以峻山碧水相辉映的环湖公路边的文武庙主祀关帝,另外加奉祀孔子与岳飞,庙内所有神像,皆用铜铸,建筑金碧辉煌,香火鼎盛。

台中

- **中社观光花市** - 是中部地区唯一低海拔种植郁金香成功的花市,透过冷藏等独特技术,调节开花顺序,每年一至三月共有十五万株轮流绽放,只要在花期前往都可感受到郁金香花海的美丽盛况,仿佛置身荷兰异国。
- **逢甲夜市** - 夜市的范围包括逢甲大学方圆一公里之内,是台中最具人气的商圈之一。商圈内贩卖种类繁多,应有尽有,衣食住行育乐全都包含,令人目不暇接,众多选择的小吃闻名遐迩。
- **彩虹眷村** - 映入眼帘的是可爱梦幻的涂鸦,色彩缤纷的色块,仿佛来到童话世界而这些涂鸦,全都出自于彩虹爷爷 - 黄永阜之手。

TAIPEI

- **XiMenDing** - Ximending has been called the "Harajuku of Taipei" and the "Shibuya of Taipei". Ximending is the source of Taiwan's fashion, subculture, and Japanese culture.
- **Shilin Night Market** - Considered to be the largest and most famous night market in the city. Great place of local handicrafts, clothes, toys, tasty local snacks and souvenirs
- **Jiufen** - A place where you get a chance to taste the local snacks and foods of Taiwan such as Taro and Sweet Potato Ball etc.
- **Shifen Old Street** - Although the Shihfen Old Street does not necessarily attract tourists due to its traditional architecture, it does boast the unique attribute of serving as the only old street in Taiwan, which trains pass through on a daily basis. As they happily enjoy delicious home-cooked noodles, visitors can enjoy the sight of trains passing along the unfenced railway gates.

NANTOU

- **QingJing Green Green Grassland** - Known as a "Foggy Eden" far away from the city area in the mountains, Qingjing Farm is great for those who enjoy fresh air, lush forests, acre of flowers along the plains and hillside, and beautiful starry nights. Located in the northern section of Qingjing Farm is Green Green Grassland, which is an open pasture ground for livestock such as sheep and cows to roam and graze freely. Visitors are able to see the animals up close and interact with them.
- **Swiss Garden** - The beautiful Northern European atmosphere at the Small Swiss Garden has given it the name of "Taiwan's Little Switzerland" and "Paradise in the Mist"
- **Carton King** - Huang Fang-liang is a Taiwanese paper artist who not only explores possibilities of paper but also creates more than fifty different products only with paper, whose creative paper company Carton King even holds over 100 patents. Carton King is a perfect result out of the sheer popularity of these paper-made products, where snacks, hot pots, afternoon tea and set menus are served. Almost everything seen in this restaurant, from dining room sets to lampshades and pots, is made with corrugated paper – Carton King is no doubt a mind-blowing wonderland of fantasy and imagination.
- **Sun Moon Lake** - is Taiwan's largest freshwater lake, located in a basin surrounded by peaks. Its beauty has given rise to such names as "Pearl in the Mountains," "Honeymoon Lake," and "Lovers' Lake." It has also been called the "Heart of Taiwan," not for romantic reasons, but for its role as a major hydropower generator.

TAICHUNG

- **Chungshe Tourist Flower Market** - is the only flower market that succeeded in growing tulips in low altitude areas of central Taiwan. By special techniques of refrigeration applied, the flowering time is regulated, and about 150,000 tulip bulbs with differing varieties are planted and in full bloom from January to March each year. So when you visit the flower market to see the tulip blossoms during the period, no matter where you look, the tulip fields will be no doubt gorgeously colorful. You'll feel as if you were in Holland without going far away there.
- **FengJia Night Market** - Due to nearby famous university, therefore lots of modern fashion, snacks, and etc you can find here.
