- 麦考里夫人(拍照) - 麦考利夫人石椅位于悉尼皇家植物园内,是为纪念麦考利夫人而由工匠雕刻的石椅。麦考利夫人座椅在皇家植物园的最北面,与悉尼歌剧院只相隔一道狭窄的海湾,是游客们必游之地。
- 悉尼歌剧院(外观) - 20世纪最具特色的建筑之一,也是世界著名的表演艺术中心,已成为悉尼市的标志性建筑。
- 岩石区 - 饱览悉尼地标建筑海港大桥的优美风光、拥有众多古老建筑历史文化,因而岩石区在游客中非常受欢迎。该区域的特色是那些琳琅满目的纪念品店、工艺品店、主题店以及有历史意义的酒吧。
- 圣母玛利亚教堂 - 南半球最大的教堂,悉尼圣母玛利亚教堂是承载了欧洲典型哥特式建筑风格的教堂。悉尼圣母玛利亚教堂位于悉尼市中心的海德公园附近,建于1885年。教堂外表,震撼人心的尖塔高耸入云,气势宏大,象征着摆脱尘世的一切包袱和重负。
- 达令港 - 又叫“情人港”,是悉尼居民和游客最爱游览的地方之一,也是一处休闲及购物的好地方。
- 帕迪市场 - 已成立150多年之久,在悉尼历史中傲居中心地位。在唐人街区,数百个摊位充斥着满满当当的商品,从纪念品到体育用品、从服装到化妆品、从鞋履到羊皮、花草、果蔬,还有一个不可思议的美食广场,真可谓琳琅满目、包罗万象。(逢周一、周二和公共假期休息,将改为皮特街购物中心替代)
- 库克船游船 - 世界上没有第二个海港可以与悉尼港的美丽与惊艳相媲美,游船观光是游览这座海港的最佳方式。您可以享用美食,搭配全世界最美丽的海港景色,绝对是超出想象的浪漫之旅。
- 安斯利山观景台 - 安斯利山是堪培拉自然公园的一部分,位于其中北部640公顷的自然保护区里。其特点是在山顶瞭望整个堪培拉市美丽的风景
- 国会大厦 - 位于澳大利亚首都堪培拉的中心,是世界上最著名的建筑之一。它以其宏伟的建筑结构著称,并以大量使用砖石和优质木材及收藏艺术精品为特色。
- 格里芬湖 - 于堪培拉中心的格里芬湖是以首都建设总监伯利格里芬命名的长达20多公里的人工湖。
- 科金顿花园 - 主打英国和其他一些国家的建筑缩小版,有点像世界公园,不过在一个景色优美的花园中。这个也有点意思,尤其是春天到了,各种花花草草开着还是很美的。不过似乎也直接导致我的花粉过敏也更严重了。
- 蓝山公园 - 2000年被列入自然类世界遗产,全地区生长着庞大的原始森林和亚热带雨林。在蓝山中心景点卡顿巴(Katoomba),可乘坐3种缆车游览丛林景色(世界上最陡的观光火车+空中缆车+横向缆车),也可以在回声台(Echo Point)领略三姐妹峰的秀美英姿。

- **Mrs Macquaries Point** – is an exposed sandstone rock cut into the shape of a bench, on a peninsula in Sydney Harbour, hand carved by convicts from sandstone in 1810 for Elizabeth Macquarie, the wife of Major-General Lachlan Macquarie, Governor of New South Wales. The peninsula itself is named Mrs Macquarie's Point, and is part of The Domain, near the Royal Botanic Gardens.
- **Sydney Opera House** – A must-visit iconic landmark of Australia that recognized by UNESCO as a Cultural Heritage. Some say, never been Great Wall, means you never been China; well Sydney say, never been the Sydney Opera House, meaning you never been Australia.
- **The Rocks Area** – The Rocks is a neighbourhood of historic laneways in the shadow of Sydney Harbour Bridge. Locals and tourists mingle at the open-air Rocks Markets, purchasing street food and handmade fashions. The area has some of Sydney's oldest pubs and many of the upscale restaurants have harbour views.
- **St Mary Cathedral** – is the cathedral church of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Sydney
- **Darling Harbour** – Sydney favourite destination for leisure and entertainment, with more than 40 restaurants, 30 bars, cafes, museums, theatres, parks and more.
- **Paddy's Market** – is a commercial enterprise that has two large markets in Sydney, New South Wales, Australia. Paddy's Markets are located in Haymarket and Flemington and specialise in the sale of fruit, vegetables, fish, clothes and giftware. (Closed on Mon, Wed & Public Holidays will replace by Pitt Street Mall)
- **Captain Cook Cruise** – Experience the world's most beautiful harbour with Captain Cook Cruises. Cruise Sydney Harbour with Captain Cook, Australia's most popular cruises and enjoy meals here.
- **Mount Ainslie Lookout** – is a hill with an elevation of 843 metres (2,766 ft) that is located in the northeastern suburbs of Canberra, in the Australian Capital Territory, Australia. Mount Ainslie lies within part of the Canberra Nature Park.
- **Parliament House** – is the meeting place of the Parliament of Australia, located in Canberra, the capital of Australia.
