墨尔本

- 战争纪念碑 - 为了纪念11万4千多名参加第一次世界大战的维多利亚州士兵, 其中1万9千名在欧洲战场上牺牲的士兵而建造的。
- 圣珀德里克教堂 - 是墨尔本也是南半球最大最高的天主教堂。这座哥特式建筑风格的大教堂, 大部分用青石建成, 由著名英籍建筑师华佗负责设计。
- 佛兹罗公园 - 公园里绿树葱葱, 鸟语花香, 带着浓厚的英国乡村浪漫色彩。园内林木青葱, 举凡花园、温室、喷泉、小湖、步道、雕像等规划优美, 还有一棵树龄高达 130 年的古木, 成为最热门的婚纱摄影地点。
- DFO South Wharf 购物中心 - 是澳洲著名之一的购物中心。
- 墨尔本之星 - 南半球唯一的巨型观景轮墨尔本之星, 欣赏绝无仅有的风景, 享受永生难忘的体验。无论是在白天或夜晚, 当墨尔本之星缓缓呈弧线上升至空中时, 您将仿佛置身于世界之巅。每一圈的风光都各不相同, 热闹繁忙的港口、风景如画的花园、流光溢彩的街道, 璀璨夺目的城市灯光, 墨尔本如一幕千变万化的戏剧, 在您的脚下徐徐展开。墨尔本之星将墨尔本的市井百态融为一体呈现眼前——阳春白雪, 下里巴人, 以及种种精灵古怪尽在其中。从墨尔本中央商务区、菲利普港湾一直到远处的马瑟顿山 (Mount Macedon) 和丹地农山脉 (Dandenong Ranges), 方圆40公里之内的锦绣河山均历历在目。
- 布莱顿海滩盒 - 也称为布莱顿彩虹屋, 具有特色的一个拍照景点。
- A Maze' N Thing游乐场 - 进入A Maze' N Thing游乐场的刹那间, 很多东西都会吸引着你的目光, 甚至让你产生错觉和假象。在这里, 你可以体验头于身体分离的错觉, 缩短你的身高, 迷失在墨镜迷宫或户外迷宫里, 从悬崖上落下, 再飞行冲浪板上快速飞行, 有很多事情值得去体验, 许多谜题等待被揭开, 很多地方等着你去探索。
- 树熊自然保护区 - 致力于保护考拉的可持生态和生存环境, 游客可以一边漫步在澳大利亚丛林中, 一边在考拉的天然栖息地中观赏野生考拉。
- 小企鹅自然生态保护区 - 菲利普岛的企鹅是世界上最小的企鹅, 身高仅30公分, 每当日落时分, 便可见到可爱企鹅们成群大摇大摆的从海上陆续归巢, 由于它们体型娇小, 排列在一起摇摇摆摆地走, 甚为有趣。(普通区平台)
- 大洋路 - 是澳洲维多利亚省的一条行车公路, 全长约276公里, 建于悬崖峭壁中间。大洋路于1920年为了纪念第一次世界大战中牺牲的人而建的。大洋路可看到最著名的景色莫过于“十二使徒岩” (The Twelve Apostles), 它们是海边一组十二块各自独立的岩石, 其数量及形态恰巧酷似耶稣的十二使徒, 因此就以圣经故事里的这“十二使徒”命名之。

MELBOURNE

- **Shrine of Remembrance** - Monument for remembering those Australian who fought bravely in war and those who suffered in war.
- **St Patrick Cathedral** - Is the cathedral church of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Melbourne in Victoria, Australia.
- **Fitzroy Garden** - These beautiful gardens have provided a place for relaxation, recreation and entertainment for all visitors.
- **DFO South Wharf** - Is one of the famous Factory Outlets in Australia.
- **Melbourne Star** - The Southern Hemisphere's only Giant Observation Wheel, for a view like no other an experience you'll never forget. Day or night, you'll feel on top of the world as the Melbourne Star glides on its gentle arc through the sky. No spin is the same, as you watch the constantly changing drama of the busy port, scenic gardens, bustling streets and bright lights of the city below. The Melbourne Star brings the whole of Melbourne together - the sophisticated, the grungy and the downright quirky - in spectacular views reaching up to 40km from Melbourne's CBD and Port Phillip Bay through to Mount Macedon and the Dandenong Ranges in the distance.
- **Brighton Beach House** - Dive into Port Phillip Bay under the watch of 82 distinctive bathing boxes, a row of uniformly proportioned wooden structures lining the foreshore at Brighton Beach. Built well over a century ago in response to very Victorian ideas of morality and seaside bathing, the bathing boxes remain almost unchanged. All retain classic Victorian architectural features with timber framing, weatherboards and corrugated iron roofs, though they also bear the hallmarks of individual licencees' artistic and colourful embellishment.
- **A Maze'N Thing** - Is a unique, award-winning theme park located on Phillip Island. It is a magical world of illusion, puzzles, mazes, magic and slide that provides hours of fun.
- **Koala Conservation Centre Admission** - Stroll through this eucalypt woodland and come 'face-to-face' with koalas in their natural habitat. The Koala Conservation Centre's unique tree top boardwalks and close viewing areas allow visitors to see how truly amazing koalas are.
- **Penguin Parade** - Ever watched Happy Feet? If you didn't, well, now you are giving a chance to meet these cute little penguins shuffling in front of your eyes in the sunset! Meanwhile, visitors also will learn the importance of conserving natural habitat and the beauty of nature environment. (Standard View Platform)
- **Great Ocean Road** - Drive one of the world's most scenic coastal touring routes, the Great Ocean Road, spanning 243 kilometres along the stunning coastline of Victoria's south-west. Take in the panoramic views as the road winds along cliff tops, up to breathtaking headlands, down onto the edge of beaches, across river estuaries and through lush rainforests. This is the most famous section of the Great Ocean Road featuring an amazing collection of rock formations known as the 12 Apostles which have been carved out of the headland by the fierce waves of the southern ocean.
