## 观光景点:



## 霍巴特

- 萨拉曼卡 - 每逢星期六, 数以百计的摊档商贩沿着广场将商品陈列在摊档上。这里汇集了众多优质艺术品及手工艺品, 如精美的玻璃器皿、富有创意的木器设计、时尚的服装、设计前卫的陶器和皮具。
- 塔斯马尼亚皇家植物园 - 澳大利亚第二古老的植物园, 建于1818年。园中有许多珍贵树木, 有些的树龄甚至可追溯到十九世纪, 在这里你可以观赏到许多原产于澳洲的植物。
- 酒杯湾 - 世界上最美的海湾之一, 位于弗雷西内国家公园里面, 躲在层层群山后面, 沙滩与塔斯曼海形成轮廓分明的半月形状, 仿佛就是一个天然的葡萄酒杯。
- 思旺西 - 塔斯马尼亚东海岸中心的一个小镇, 位于大牡蛎湾西北岸, 俯瞰着菲欣纳国家公园。这是在霍巴特和悉尼之后成立的第一个澳大利亚直辖市。
- 菲欣纳半岛 - 位于塔斯马尼亚东海岸。公园内有粉红色的花岗岩山, 雪白的沙滩, 海岸上海风吹积而成的沙丘和干燥桉树林。1802年法国探险家Nicolas Baudin以探险队船长菲欣纳(Freycinet)兄弟的名字为此地命名。
- 阿瑟港 - 世界文化遗产地, 位于塔斯曼半岛南端, 曾是著名的罪犯流放地。许多建筑物被拆除或者烧毁, 现有的都是遗址。
- 海盗湾 - 可以观赏到绵延不尽的海岸线, 海盗湾位于霍巴特东南部。
- 鹰脖湾 - 有很多奇观的岩石构造, 包括魔鬼厨房 (Devils Kitchen)、塔斯曼拱门 (Tasman's Arch)、喷水洞 (Blow Hole) 和棋盘石形地面 (Tessellated Pavement)。

## 朗塞斯顿

- 谢菲尔德壁画小镇 - 镇内壁画随处可见, 疯狂的艺术家和专业画家几乎令全镇没有半壁空白, 故它有“壁画之城”的美誉。这些壁画即便是即兴涂鸦, 许多也是出自当代极具盛名的大师级艺术家之手。
- 摇篮谷 - 因连绵的山脉状如摇篮而得名。摇篮山群峰是塔斯马尼亚荒野最为人们熟知的景象之一, 也是占地161000公顷的摇篮山-圣克莱尔湖国家公园 (Cradle Mountain-Lake St Clair National Park) 的北端和塔斯马尼亚荒野世界遗产区 (Tasmanian Wilderness World Heritage Area) 的一部分。
- 鸽子湖 - 景色迷人, 山湖相依, 相得益彰。湖映山色, 山壮水碧, 原始自然的风貌给人震撼, 湖水可以直接饮用。游览的路径掩藏在深林之中, 远远望去山湖自然景色依旧, 毫无人工痕迹。
- 塔马河湿地公园 - 塔马岛上有湿地和大片的芦苇草, 环境开阔, 是重要的鸟类栖息地, 对游客来说则是观鸟胜地, 在岛上可以观赏栖息在湿地和泻湖上的品种丰富的鸟类, 享受宁静的休闲时光。
- 卡德奈特峡谷 - 塞斯顿中心内独特的自然形态, 是任何城市罕见的自然现象。漫步在沿着悬崖峭壁的小路上, 俯瞰南埃斯克河, 穿过国王桥, 欣赏这座古老的岩石峡谷的壮丽景色。可自费购买的峡谷风景缆车让您体验世界上最长的单轨缆车。
- 瑞士风情小镇 - 环境优美、极具魅力的瑞士格林德尔瓦尔德村, 充满诗意的风光, 让人有留在这里定居的冲动。顺着小镇湖畔逛一圈, 尖顶的教堂里传出悠扬钟声, 更增添了小镇的安宁祥和气氛。

## HOBART

- **Salamanca Place** - Every Saturday, more than 300 stallholders bring Salamanca Place to life with the bustling Salamanca Market, Tasmania's most famous market. Stock up on fresh produce, take home gourmet delicatessen treats or hunt for an antique as you listen to the tunes of busking musicians.
- **Royal Tasmanian Botanical Gardens** - It is the second oldest botanical garden in Australia and was built in 1818. There are many precious trees in the park, some even dating back to the nineteenth century, where you can admire many plants native to Australia.
- **Wineglass Bay** - One of the most beautiful gulfs in the world, nestled in Freycinet National Park, hiding behind layers of mountains, forming a well-defined half moon shape along the beach and the Tasman Sea as if it were a natural wine glass.
- **Swansea** - A town in the heart of Tasmania's east coast, on the north-west shore of Great Oyster Bay and overlooking Freycinet National Park. It was the first municipality in Australia to be established after Hobart and Sydney.
- **Freycinet Peninsula** - A large peninsula located on the eastern coast of Tasmania, Australia. The peninsula is located north of Schouten Island and is contained within the Freycinet National Park.
- **Port Arthur** - A small town and former convict settlement on the Tasman Peninsula, in Tasmania, Australia. Port Arthur is one of Australia's most significant heritage areas and an open-air museum.
- **Eaglehawk Neck** - Is a narrow isthmus that connects the Tasman Peninsula with the Forester Peninsula, and hence to mainland Tasmania.
- **Pirates Bay** - Are some very interesting coastal features. A name like Devils Kitchen can only conjure up interest. Tasman Arch is a short stroll away. At Tasman Arch there is also a path that leads to a dramatic view of the coast to the south. The Blowhole is a short drive away. The road to both passes through the shack hamlet of Doo Town.

## LAUNCESTON

- **Sheffield Town** - Delightful murals are painted on the side walls of most of the buildings throughout the town. Experience the history told through art, as you wander through Tasmania's Outdoor Art Gallery.
- **Cradle Valley** - The Cradle Mountain is a mountain in the Central Highlands region of the Australian state of Tasmania. The mountain is situated in the Cradle Mountain-Lake St Clair National Park. At 1,545 metres (5,069 ft) above sea level, it is the fifth-highest mountain in Tasmania, and is one of the principal tourist sites in the state.
- **Dove Lake Circuit** - The Dove Lake Circuit and Marions Lookout hike is a great intro to Cradle Mountain area. It will take you around Dove Lake and then up to Marions Lookout. On a good day the views are absolutely breathtaking.
- **Tamar Island Wetlands** - The Tamar Island Wetlands is a unique urban wetlands reserve just a ten-minute drive from Launceston. A short (500 metre) walk from the interpretation centre takes you to a bird hide with seating where you can observe wetland birds on the lagoon and enjoy a restful break.
- **Cataract Gorge** - A unique natural formation within the Launceston central, a rare natural phenomenon in any city. A stroll following the pathway along the cliff face, looking down onto the South Esk River and crossing the Kings Bridge for the spectacular views of this ancient rock gorge. Gorge Scenic Chairlift available at own expenses for those would like to experience the world's longest single span chairlift.
